



Winter dinghy storage – use of locked compound

Conditions of use

Dinghies ONLY	No large boats including keel boats, yachts, RIBs or camper vans.
No liability	The BSC will not accept any responsibility for loss or damage. Owners must ensure that their dinghy and trailer is adequately insured.
Identification	All dinghies/trailers must be clearly marked with the owners' name.
Maintenance	Minor maintenance/repairs can be carried out but no restoration projects please. Any rubbish/waste must be removed immediately.
Padlocks	Dinghies can be padlocked to their trailers but not to the fence or any other structure. This is to enable them to be moved within the compound if necessary e.g. for grass cutting.
Fee	£25 Fees are subject to periodic review by the committee.
Sails / rig	The BSC does not presently have storage facilities for members' sails or rigs so these must either be left on the boat or stored elsewhere.
Access	For access to the compound contact one of the committee members in order to borrow a key. Any members requiring access will be held responsible for ensuring that the compound is left locked.
Right to remove	Any dinghies that cannot be identified, are causing an obstruction or if fees are not paid in advance, will be moved to the dingy park for collection by their owner.
Storage Period	1 st November – 31 st March. Dinghies must be removed from the compound to the main dinghy park or elsewhere by the 1 st April.
